Nursing Scholarship

Outstanding Military Service Scholarship

The Outstanding Military Service Scholarship is awarded to students with long-term and/or exemplary service in the armed forces. Eligibility includes active-duty men and women, honorably discharged military veterans, as well as spouses and children of service members. Proof of military status or DD214 of a service member is required. Please provide written documentation and the purpose related to your volunteer service, including your educational goals and service to your community.

Law Enforcement Scholarship

The Law Enforcement Scholarship is awarded to students who have participated in the Junior Reserve Law Enforcement program, Teen Police Academy, and anyone who has the desire to serve their community in the field of Law Enforcement. Please provide written documentation and the purpose related to your volunteer service, including your educational goals and service to your community.



PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must:

- Be currently enrolled as of Fall 2023 at Keiser University (Any Campus or Online Location).
- Have achieved a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Be a U.S. citizen or resident alien (green card holder).
- Provide documentation verifying their past professional involvements deemed applicable for the Scholarship for which they are applying.
- Application must be submitted by November 17, 2023
- Nursing and Law Enforcement Scholarships Only:
 - Agree in writing to pursue a career in the profession or related field related to which you are applying, within a year of graduation from Keiser University.



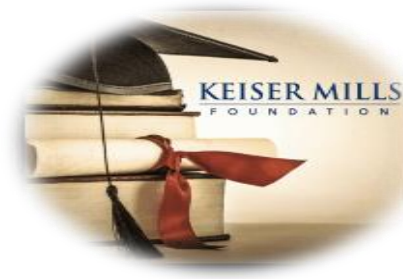
2023 Keiser Mills Scholarship Description:

A total of nine scholarships will be awarded, not exceeding three scholarships per Scholarship category. Each scholarship will award \$2,500 to the recipient for their use in the Spring 2024 semester at Keiser University (Online or Any Campus Location). All scholarship awards will apply as a one-time award, not in perpetuity. All complete applications will be reviewed and awarded by the Keiser Scholarship Committee.

- Have achieved a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Be a U.S. citizen or [eligible noncitizen](#);
- Provide documentation verifying their past professional involvements deemed applicable for the Scholarship for which they are applying.
- Submit their application, in its entirety by November 17, 2023. Partial applications will not be considered.

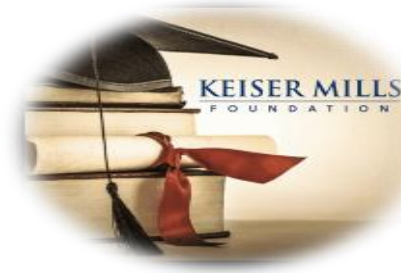

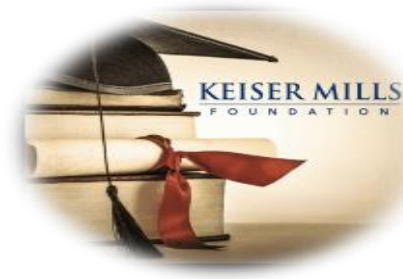
